 - Monthly Revenues As expected there were no monthly revenues. Year to date income total is \$73,022.
 - Monthly Expenses Expenses were collected this month from room reps, teacher

- classroom supplies, sunshine fund, and staff appreciation. Year to date expenses total \$53,552.
- Cash Carry Forward Balance Currently reporting a cash carry forward balance of \$47,712.
- Impact of COVID19 on the budget- We are experiencing a decrease in revenue due to canceling some buy in parties and the possibility of having to refund those that purchased and planned these parties. Expenses are also decreased resulting from the cancelation of the end of the year events. Will continue to monitor.
