Lincoln School Talent Show Rules

We hope you will share your talent with us!! Please be sure to read The Rules below, as you will be asked during online registration whether you agree with them.

- 1. Participation is open to Lincoln School students only.
- 2. Participants may only perform in one act, whether it is a solo or group act.
- 3. Participants may express any talent (singing, music ability, comedy, poetry, reading, dancing, etc.) as long as it is appropriate for an elementary aged audience and safe, in the opinion of the Lincoln Talent Show Organizing Committee.
- 4. <u>All acts must adhere to a strict 2-minute time limit.</u>
- 5. No lip syncing is allowed. Unless your name is Milli or Vanilli (ask your parents!).
- 6. No profanity is allowed.
- We will offer two rehearsal dates on the stage in advance of the show. The first date is Tuesday, February 21st from 3:30 - 5:30pm; and the second is Wednesday, February 22nd from 3:30 - 5:30pm.
- 8. You must be able to attend one of the two rehearsal dates. If you are not able to attend a rehearsal, you will not perform at the Talent Show.
- 9. School rules must be observed while performing or rehearsing on school grounds.
- 10. As a parent or guardian, I accept full responsibility for my child's during both the audition and the performance. Any acts consisting of three or more students must have at least two parents present during the rehearsal and the performance.
- 11. Please be aware that any one song can only be used in one act. If you have a specific song that you would like to use for your act, please register as early as possible. If two or more acts want to use the same song, the first registrant (all registrations are time stamped) will have use of the song, while other acts will need to find an alternate song.
- 12. You will be asked to sign a District Waiver/Release of Liability during the online registration process. If you do not sign the waiver, your child will not be eligible to participate in the Talent Show.

These rules are subject to change at the discretion of the Lincoln Talent Show Organizing Committee, which includes the Co-Chairs as well as the Music and Communications Managers. Enforcement of these rules is subject to the Organizing Committee's discretion and judgment. All decisions of the Organizing Committee are final.
