o For Ways and Means, we processed our final Trivia Night expenses, and Ways and Means expenses to date is $\$ 1648$.
o Our net expense to date is $\$ 771$, leaving us with $\$ 35,997$ cash carried forward

- School Supply Kits: Kelly Boza has worked with reps from the other host schools and kits are approved.
- 5th grade DARE starting tomorrow. A little over half of the fifth grade class has signed up to participate
- Teacher appreciation week: Andrea Mostardi reported on activities for the first week of May. Each day of the week will have a theme. Everything will be delivered to teachers lounge vs classrooms. Monday is "thanks a latte" Tuesday is "thanks a million" (gift bags including lottery tickets, chocolate coins), Wednesday "Nacho average teacher" will have catered lunch teachers order ahead of time.Thursday "thank you for helping me grow" with flower arrangements (provided by students) which will be set up in the outdoor tents. Friday "How Sweet it is to be Taught by you" coffee and scones in the am, and Kristin Morrow will provide monthly staff lunch that day. The ice cream truck will be available after school for teachers after school. No need for lunch Wednesday and Friday.
- Field Day: Laura Coomer reported on field day committee. Dates will be $5 / 25 \mathrm{~K}-2 n d, 5 / 26$ will be $3-5$ th. Each day will consist of 90 minutes for all grades except Kindergarten will be one hour. Committee is currently working on time slots for each grade so that time does not conflict with lunch. Each classroom will have opportunity for 10 volunteers. There will be 9 activities. Two parent volunteers at each station and one parent to chaperone each group. Each class will be split into three groups, except for 2nd and 4th grade will be split into two groups. Theme this year will be summer olympics. Olympic podium photo booth, archery, ice pops, olympic ring relay, bouncy horse race, discus throw, limbo/hula hoop, shotput bucket drop, dance station, "Covid-friendly" tattoos. The committee plans to use the baseball fields and teacher parking lots. Mrs. Barnabee stated that groupings need to stay within numbers under 50 to be outside. Volunteers will have to self certify.
