## **VP Programs** – Celia Grebs and Kristy Maiers

- Assemblies (Kristy Maiers)- The next all school assembly is set for 2/28 and has an anti-bullying theme.
- STEM Fest (Kristi Phipps)- First group just took place and had good participation. Trying a different set up this year, split differently with half of presentation in groups and the other half in an assembly format. Great feedback so far. The next group is set to go on Thursday

- Trivia Night (Kristy Maiers)- Coming up on February 28<sup>th</sup>. Registration went fine and there is still space for more to sign up
- Talent Show (Kristy Maiers)- 33 acts are currently registered. Still too many parent spectators to fit in the gym if we had one act so will plan on two acts. Working on rehearsal schedule.
- Junior Great Books (Megan Melson)- We are wrapping up JGB for the year. Less interest this year with small
  groups due to the not so popular required books. We want to look into possibly forming a book club for the

### Principal – Jennifer Barnabee

 Welcome Jim Pluskota and Laura Gibson, Edison PTA president last year, to share with us the process of construction at Edison.

## Special Guest: Jim Pluskota, Edison Elementary School Principal

- 13<sup>th</sup> year at Edison as principal.
- Edison was asked to put together a community committee of teachers, parents and the principal. They met
  with the design company and architects and provided a lot of input. Some issues were in their control and
  some not in control of the parent group. Some parents felt they have not met often enough. They also had
  community engagement events, where they invited community members and parents. There were three of
  these meetings and about 100 attended.
- As of right now things have been running very smooth
- Laura shared they conducted a round table presentation with the teachers and selected parents. There were
  about 4 of those meeting. They took in the input from the group. There also were community group
  meetings where the neighbors came in and gave input. Parents could also attend these meetings and
  provide input. They strongly encourage attending the community meetings. A lot of the issues that came up
  in the meetings were addressed.
- Most of the concerns were from the parents about how the students are going to be in the building during the construction process.
- The Edison community is excited to have the Lincoln students during the construction year. He wants
  everyone to feel comfortable and welcome at Edison and hopes this will make the Elmhurst community
  come together.
- Next year starts Lincoln sending kindergarteners to Edison for all day kindergarten. The challenge will be drop off if you have a kindergartener at Edison and kids at Lincoln as well. Currently 69 students are registered for all day kindergarten at Edison.
- Edison construction period is March 2020-August 2021. August 2021 the Lincoln students come over.
- March 2020 construction plan at Edison includes adding to the parking lot and a temporary playground to the front of building for the students to play. A construction trailer will be added between Edison and Sandburg.
- The construction company was very flexible with what we wanted and workable with us to meet our school needs.
- Combining Lincoln and Edison PTA's is important. Both schools have a lot of traditions. It would be a smart to start the discussion now and figure out how to run the PTA together as well as how we will fundraiser and co mingle. A meeting is set up with both school's principal, vice principal, PTA president elect and President

from Edison and Lincoln.
