HEALTH RECORD COMPLIANCE

All Kindergartners in IL:

- Physical exam vaccines documented and completed within the year
- *Illinois Child Health Exam Form* must be complete, including health history section, diabetes and lead screening, and parent signature.
- Physical exams and vaccinations DUE no later than OCTOBER 15th,
 2020. Students who do not meet requirements EXCLUDED from school until compliance is met.
- Eye exam completed by licensed ophthalmologist or optometrist and dated within the year. <u>Eye exam forms DUE October 15, 2020</u>.
- Dental exam completed and dated within the past 18 months. <u>Dental</u>
 <u>exam forms DUE May 15, 2021.</u>

HEALTH OFFICE CHECKLIST

Attendance/Illness Reporting:

24-hour attendance line for all absences, 630-617-2366

Keep your child home if:

- Temp equal or above 100.0 degrees
- Vomiting and/or diarrhea
- Unexplained rash
- Symptoms of pink eye (unexplained redness, itchiness, drainage or crust from one or both eyes)
- Persistent cough, runny nose or sore throat
- ** Child may return to school after being fever-free and without episodes of vomiting/ diarrhea for 24 hours without use of meds **

Medications - During school hours discouraged, reserved for emergencies or unavoidable circumstances DISTRICT 205 POLICY

- All meds unopened, unexpired and have full prescription label
- Each med must have (no exception) District 205
 Med Administration Authorization form
- Emergency meds Epinephrine, Benadryl or rescue inhalers, must have <u>Action Plan</u> (Food Allergy, Insect Allergy, Asthma, etc.)
- All forms completed by physician and dated after June 1, 2020
